BLDE (Deemed to be University):



BLDE is a reputed university in Karnataka, providing education in various medical courses. Established under the BLDE Association, it operates a range of institutions across the state. The institution is represented by the Registrar and hereinafter referred to as the "Second Party."

Collective Reference:

Yenepoya (Deemed to be University) and BLDE (Deemed to be University) will hereinafter be collectively referred to as "Parties" or individually as "Party," as applicable.

Scope of work:

Whereas, Both Parties recognize the importance of collaborative efforts to promote research and publication by utilizing the facilities and expertise of both institutions. This MoU aims to establish a framework for mutual cooperation and resource-sharing for the benefit of both Parties.

Article I. Principle of Cooperation on Research and Publication


Both Parties agree to develop academic and research collaborations under the principles of mutual understanding and shared interests. Specific objectives include:

1. Promoting networking among scientists of both institutions.
2. Jointly working on areas of common research interest, including preparation and implementation of proposals aligned with National Health Priorities.
3. Laboratory Facilities: Allowing shared access to specialized labs to foster innovative research.
4. Resource Sharing: Facilitating access to library and digital resources to enhance the academic environment.
5. Data Sharing: Ensuring secure and ethical research data sharing to promote impactful scientific contributions.
6. Utilizing expertise and facilities through training, brainstorming sessions, seminars, workshops, and meetings.
7. Facilitating the exchange of academic, research, and training materials.
8. Encouraging other mutually agreed activities for institutional and individual benefits.
9. Supporting faculty and student exchanges to enhance academic and research collaborations.
10. Data generated through Collaborative research will be jointly published in scientific journals and intellectual property rights (IPR) will be shared equitably.

For each identified joint project envisaged to be taken up in collaborative mode, a separate specific MoU reflecting the details of the study, team, mutual responsibilities, financial agreements etc. may be signed where ever needed, especially in case of undertaking collaborative multi-centric Clinical Trials & Major Research Projects.

Article II. Duration and Termination of the MoU

1. This MoU becomes effective on the date of execution by both Parties and will remain valid for FIVE years, with the option for renewal.
2. Amendments may be made by mutual written consent of both Parties.

3. Either Party may terminate the MoU with six months' written notice, ensuring ongoing obligations and projects are completed.
4. Termination does not affect pre-approved binding offers or obligations.

Article III. Financial Aspects

1. There will be no financial liability among the Parties.
2. Travel and incidental expenses will be borne by the visiting Party, while the Host Institution will provide accommodation and local hospitality.
3. Costs of research materials will be borne by the respective institution.
4. Intellectual expertise and affordable services will be shared without establishing exclusive rights or privileges.

Article IV. Miscellaneous

1. If any provision of this MoU is deemed invalid, the remaining provisions will remain effective.
2. This MoU does not create a legal partnership or agency relationship between the Parties.
3. Information generated during collaborative studies must not be shared with third parties without mutual consent.
4. Both Parties will comply with all applicable laws of Karnataka.


