



Lecture Highlights:

Dr. Hoti commenced the lecture by providing a comprehensive overview of NTDs, highlighting their prevalence, impact on vulnerable populations, and the challenges associated with their control and elimination. He then delved into the specifics of filariasis, covering:

- Epidemiology and Transmission: Dr. Hoti elucidated the transmission dynamics of lymphatic filariasis, emphasizing the role of mosquito vectors and the socio-environmental factors contributing to its spread.
- Clinical Manifestations and Diagnosis: He discussed the various clinical manifestations of filariasis, including lymphedema and hydrocele, and outlined the diagnostic methods employed for accurate identification.
- Treatment Strategies: Dr. Hoti elaborated on the current treatment protocols for filariasis, including mass drug administration (MDA) and individual patient management. He provided valuable insights into the efficacy and potential side effects of available medications.
- Elimination Efforts: The lecture focused significantly on the global and national efforts towards the elimination of filariasis. Dr. Hoti discussed the strategies implemented under the national programs, including vector control, morbidity management, and disability prevention. He also highlighted the challenges and opportunities in achieving the elimination targets.
- Research and Innovation: Dr. Hoti emphasized the importance of ongoing research and innovation in developing new diagnostic tools, drugs, and vector control strategies. He shared his experiences and insights from his extensive research career at ICMR, VCRC.
- Public Health Importance: The speaker stressed the importance of community involvement and public awareness campaigns in controlling and eliminating NTDs.


Interaction and Q&A Session:
